



SR 87 Teesto Wash Bridge BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation has initiated a bridge replacement project at the Teesto Wash Bridge (milepost 385) along State Route 87. Work will include replacing the existing bridge with a new two-span bridge, roadway realignment work, guardrail replacement, pavement marking replacement and other related work.

WHAT TO EXPECT

North- and southbound SR 87 will be narrowed to one lane only with alternating travel beginning in March 2023 and continuing through fall 2023.

Traffic will be controlled by a temporary traffic-control signal.

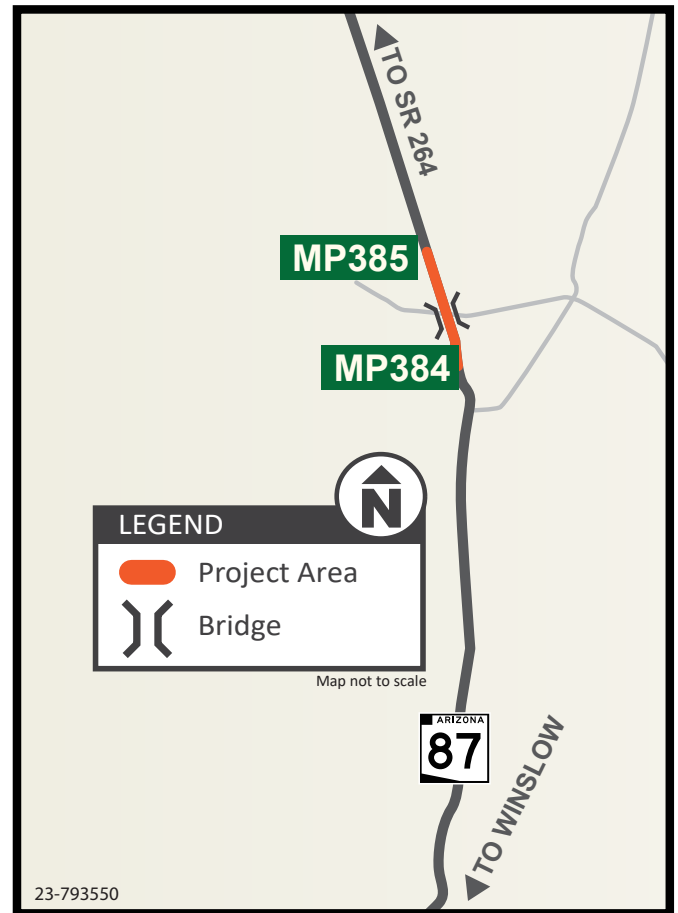
Drivers need to be prepared to slow down and stop in the work zone and use caution around construction personnel and equipment while the restrictions are in place.
